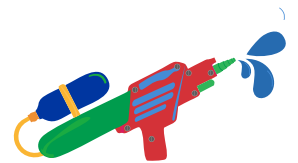

Dress everyday as your favorite hero!*

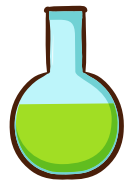
A guest reader from the Moorer Library will visit us!
